Setup and Workings

Set up details

1. Create a twitter account for your team (<http://twitter.com>)
2. Associate a mobile number to this account. (typically your captain's/manager's number)
3. Create a team logo (NOT MANDATORY, BUT RECOMMENDED) and upload to your team's twitter account.
4. Send an email to CricBay WebMaster asking CricBay twitter account to "Follow" your team account.

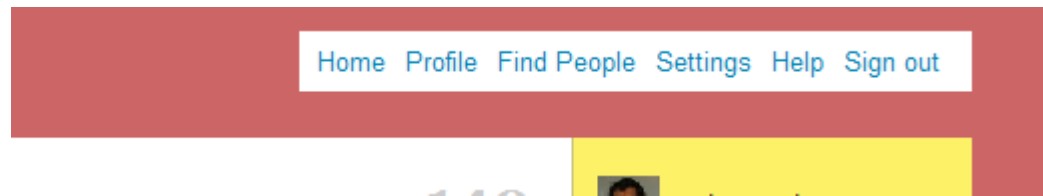



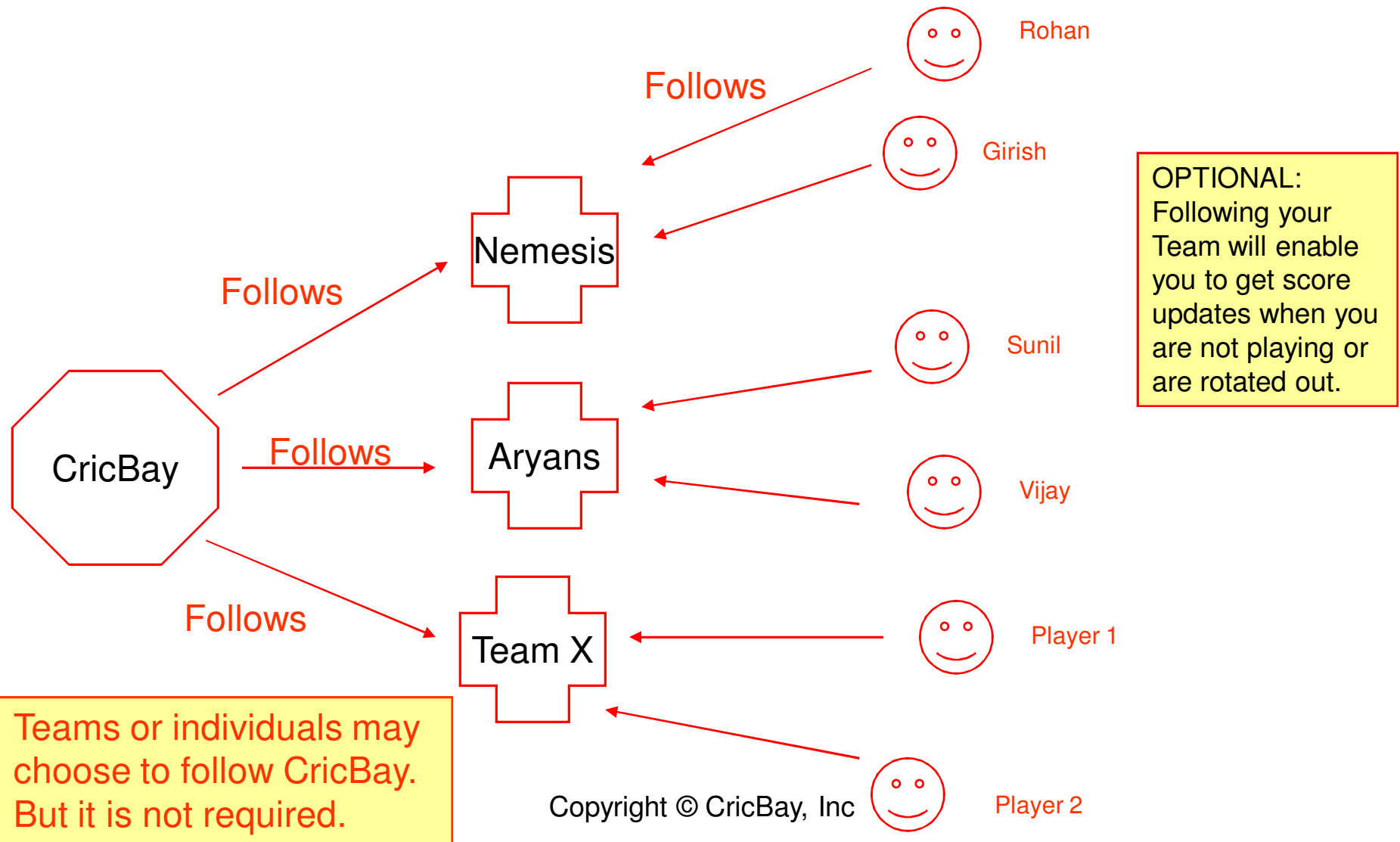
Post-Creation Association with CricBay

- This is important. After the twitter account is set up, please send an email to the CricBay webmaster asking him to follow your team's twitter.
- If this is not done, your updates will not appear in CricTicker.

Live update of scores

- During the match, use SMS on your mobile phone to update your teams twitter. (If you have a web-ready mobile device, you can use it instead of SMS)
- Ideally updates should be made at the following times: (We had some issues with updates coming in late and in the wrong order, limiting the updates will help minimize this issue)
 - Toss
 - 10 over break first innings
 - Innings break
 - Final score(If both teams are signed on, the first two updates can be sent by team batting first and the next two by team batting second)
- Use short, but precise update messages.
(eg:Nemesis choose to bat
Nemesis 11/1 in 5)

Additional uses

- Rotated players / injured players can follow scores live via twitter SMS. They need to set up a personal account and associate a mobile number to it.
- And then choose to “Follow” the team’s twitter.
- Alternatively they can follow on Cricbay’s website which will show aggregated tweets from all live matches.
